December 2018

1. Field work at Sukhana Dam, Aurangabad District, Maharashtra

In project Phase-I, a field work at Sukhana Dam is done by final year Civil Engineering students: Patil Anant, Patil Vishwajeet, Rathod Akash, Sanap Sanket. These students are doing their project under the guidance of Dr. K. T. Patil and in collaboration with Resource Engineering Centre, Maharashtra Engineering Research Institute, Nashik (MERI).

A five-day visit was arranged to collect the data with the help of DGPS instrument. On first day MDDL (maximum drawdown level) has been marked & on second day marking of FRL (full reservoir level) was done. Then on remaining three days intermediate readings between MDDL and FRL were recorded. Total 885 readings were recorded in DGPS instrument at various points. Daily data was backed up in computer for uploading in Trimble Business Centre software which uploads data directly on Google earth software to get reference for further work. The data will be post processed for determination of sedimentation occurred in reservoir.
