Online session on Block chain

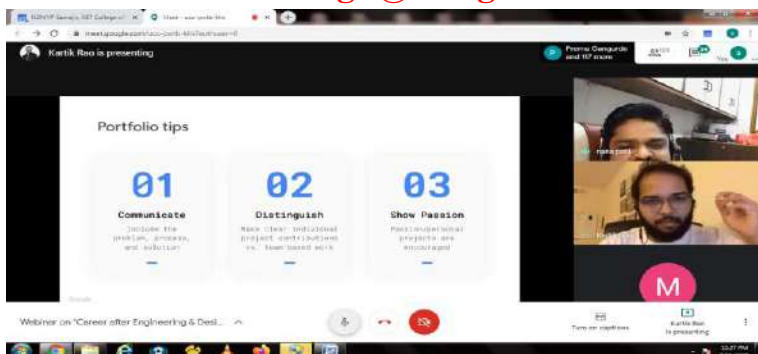

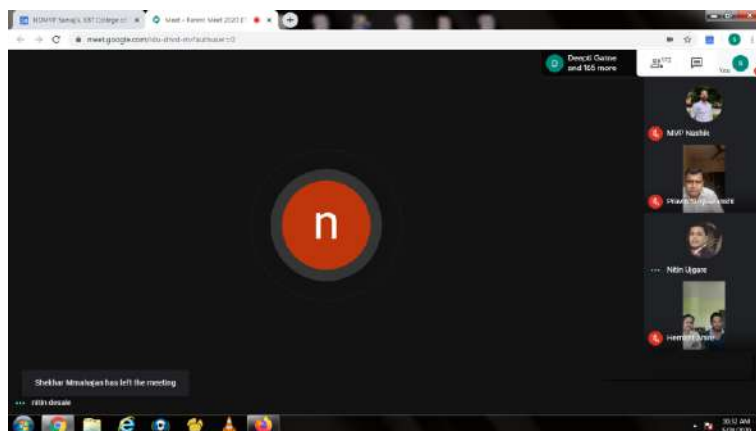
Online webinar on “Career after Engineering & Design@Google”

Virtual Parent Meet



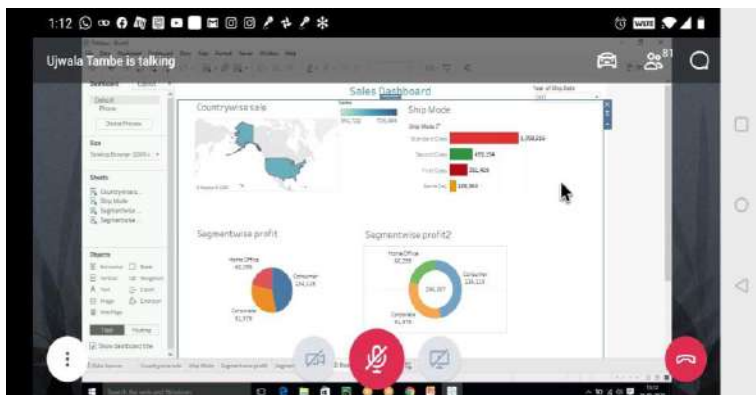

Webinar on “Career in Cyber Security and Data Forensics investigation”

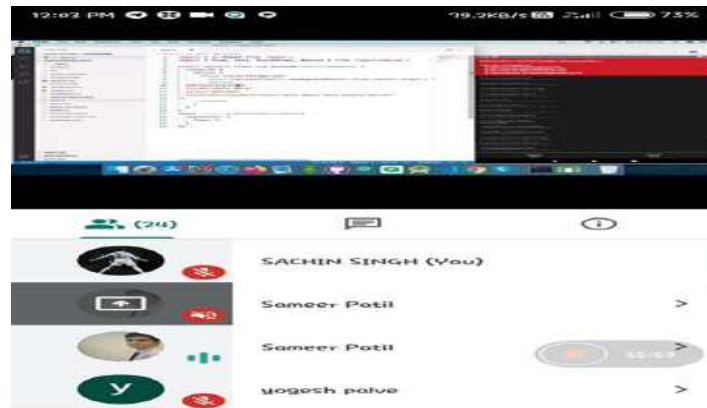

Webinar on "Software Testing & IT Job Market after COVID -19 Pandemic”

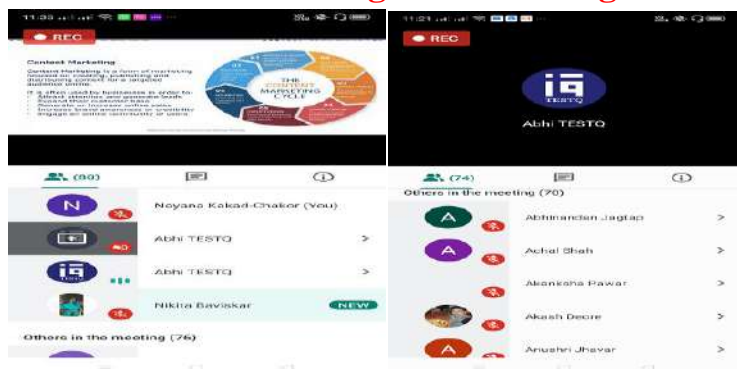
The Department of Information Technology of MVPS's K.B.T College of Engineering, Nashik organized webinar
