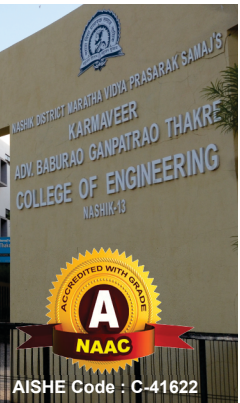
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KBT COE NEWS LETTER

The Department of Electronics & Telecommunication Engineering organized an industrial visit at "104.2 MY FM" for Second Year students on 31st January 2020.

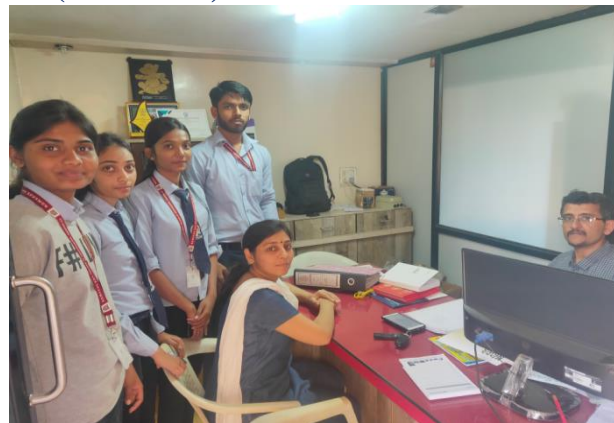
▪ **GMRT, Narayangaon (Dist - Pune) (31/01/2020)**
