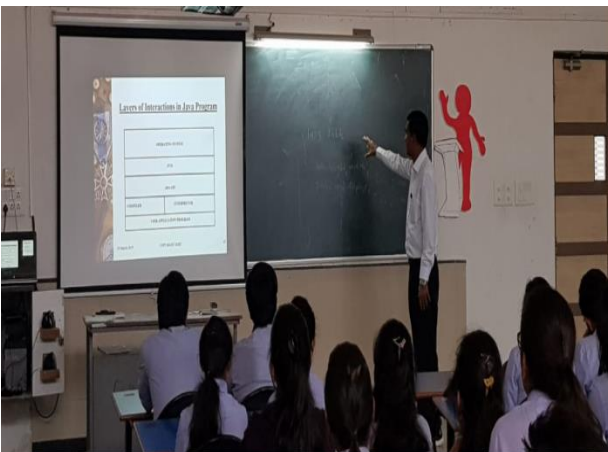


▪ **“Positive Attitude at Work” (20/03/2019)**

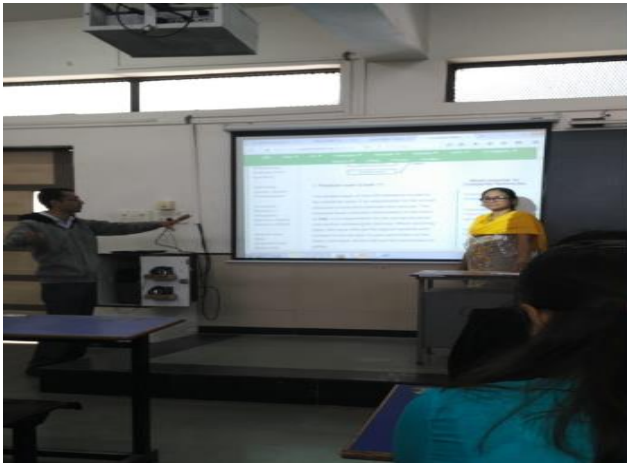
